Streamlining the bin collections.

3 bins instead of 3 bins and 2 boxes. – All recycling to go into a larger red bin – glass, tins, plastics and cardboards. Fresh Food Waste can now be put into the brown (green waste) bin, that will be collected weekly. Bigger Red bons will start to be distributed from 1st January and new collections will go live on w/c 28th March.

Engineering problem at Ancholme Leisure centre means that the main pool will remain closed for approximately 6 week. These emergency works are unplanned and unavoidable/ Small pool remains open. Bus offer of £3 return to Barton and Pods means accessible swimming for under 16s.

Hopefully a solution to the Market Stalls will be resolved very soon ..update at next meeting.

All potholes reported. Roads on the remembrance parade route have been costed, so expected works soon.

New Cemetery gate on Eastfield Road as it was beyond repair.
